Huatulco, formally known as Bahias de Huatulco, is a town in the southern coast of the Mexican state of Oaxaca. Huatulco has a population of 50,000. The nine Huatulco bays stretch for 20 miles along the coast. You can charter a boat and relax on any of its thirty-six unspoiled beaches. It is home to one of the most important coral reef systems of the Mexican Pacific.

One of the local delicacies served in Huatulco are grasshoppers! They're usually served fried with lemon, salt, and chili. If you're the adventurous type, you may want to try them! The average temperature in Huatulco, Mexico is between 75 and 88 degrees Fahrenheit.. When packing for Huatulco think casual and cool. Be sure to bring your beach wear, sandals, shorts, tank tops, and light dresses.



Climate

This city has a tropical climate. The summers are much rainier than the winters in Huatulco. There are approximately 310 days of sunshine each year. The rainy season typically occurs between June and September. This is also when the hurricane season occurs on the eastern side of Mexico but, while Huatulco can experience more intense rainfall at this time, the city is well out of the path of hurricanes.

Excursions and Cultural Highlights

Huatulco is filled with historical nature you can explore by hiking, rafting, and ATV's. Discover exotic cascading waterfalls among the wild forest landscape at Magic Falls. You can walk around waterfalls and swim in the clear turquoise pools. Sport fishing is very popular in Huatulco as well as scuba diving and snorkeling to catch a view of the amazing coral reefs you have to see to believe!
